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
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



"I had lots of books at home. But I could not read them for very long because my legs hurt more if I stood still for too long.




"While I was making my legs strong I created stories in my mind in place of reading my books. My imagination was far reaching. I made up all sorts of stories. It was lots of fun.

"Julie, do you believe that you can read well and write well?"


